Winter 2015, Shelter Report

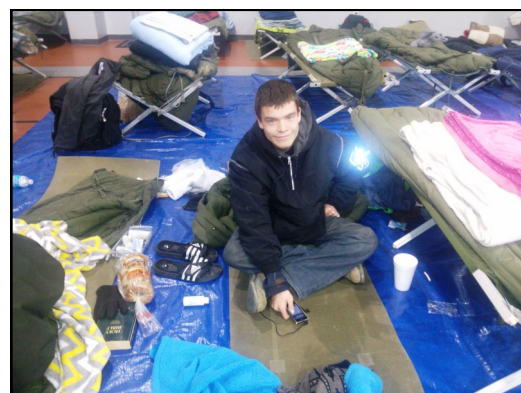
