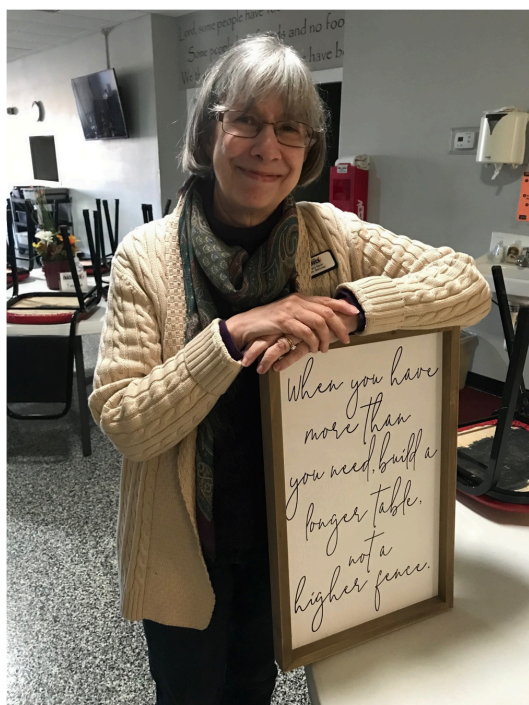


GIVING TUESDAY 2024
