In the past several months we have sure had our taste of adversity at Inasmuch. One night in January we had a break-in at the back door. Then a few weeks later, in February, the donated shower trailer that we have used for the past two years randomly caught fire in the middle of the day. Plus, we had a termite infestation in March.

Even in the midst of such adversity, we also have experienced reminders of God's provision and presence. Over 300 volunteers representing 44 different churches, businesses, and civic organizations have come to serve over 4,000 breakfasts at Inasmuch in 2022. We raised \$35,000 in our annual Bread-n-Bowls fundraiser. And we relaunched our White Flag shelter at The Lodge during the month of February. We can see God's faithfulness on display in numerous faces, places in our community, and friends. By providing a space where our Inasmuch family can routinely experience a breath of fresh air, a bright smile from loving Christ-followers, and a delicious hot meal we are offering hope to the hurting.
